

Mobile Phone Agreement

At Broxbourne CE Primary School, we recognise that some families may choose to send their Year 5 or 6 child to school with a mobile phone if they are a 'lone walker' or if they walk home without an adult.

The school does not encourage any child to bring in a phone but understands that some parents/carers may choose for this to happen.

Please read, understand and discuss the following statements with your child. Please then sign this agreement and return it to the school office.

- Phones that come into school are not the responsibility of the school and Broxbourne CE School will take no responsibility for any loss or damage of the phone.
- Any phone must be switched off on school premises.
- No child will use their phone- for any purpose whilst on school premises.
- No phone may be brought on any school trip- whether local; for a day visit or on a residential.
- Only children who walk to or from school without a parent or carer may bring their phone to school (unless they have explicitly obtained permission from the school for another, specific reason).
- If a child is found to be using their phone in school, this is in direct breach of the Behaviour Policy and will be dealt with in line with this.
- If a child is found to have a phone in school without permission from their parent/carer (as evidenced by this agreement) they will be expected to hand it in to a member of Senior Leadership and the phone will only be returned to their parent or carer.
